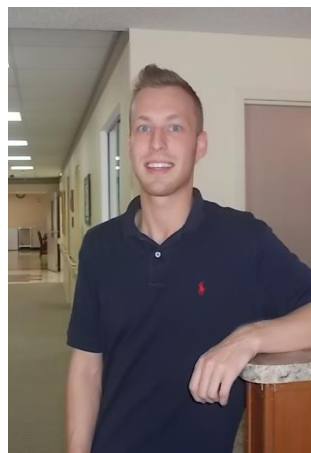

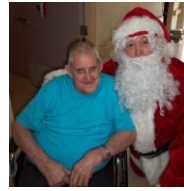


There are exciting changes taking place on our Cumberland unit, as it undergoes an extensive renovation. We ask everyone to be patient during this process.
