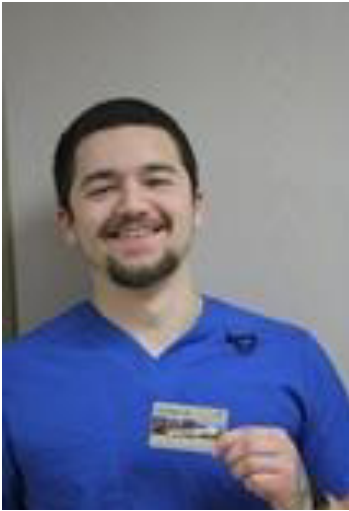

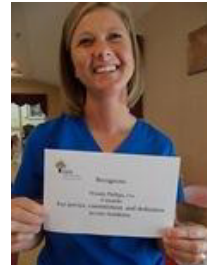


Stars of the Month
