Dr. Abdul-Latif Almatari returns to Lee Health and Rehabilitation

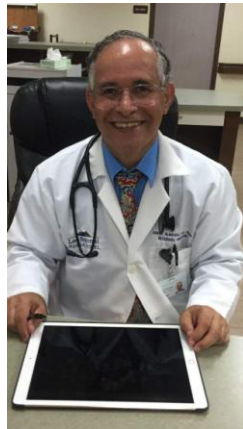
Lee Health and Rehab welcomes Dr. Abdul-Latif Almatari back to our Center.

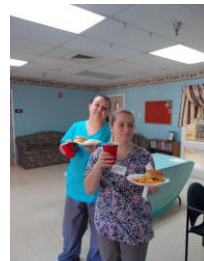
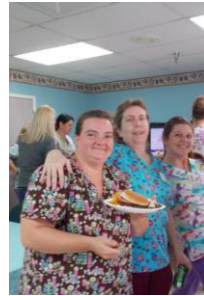
