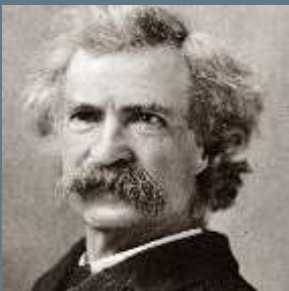

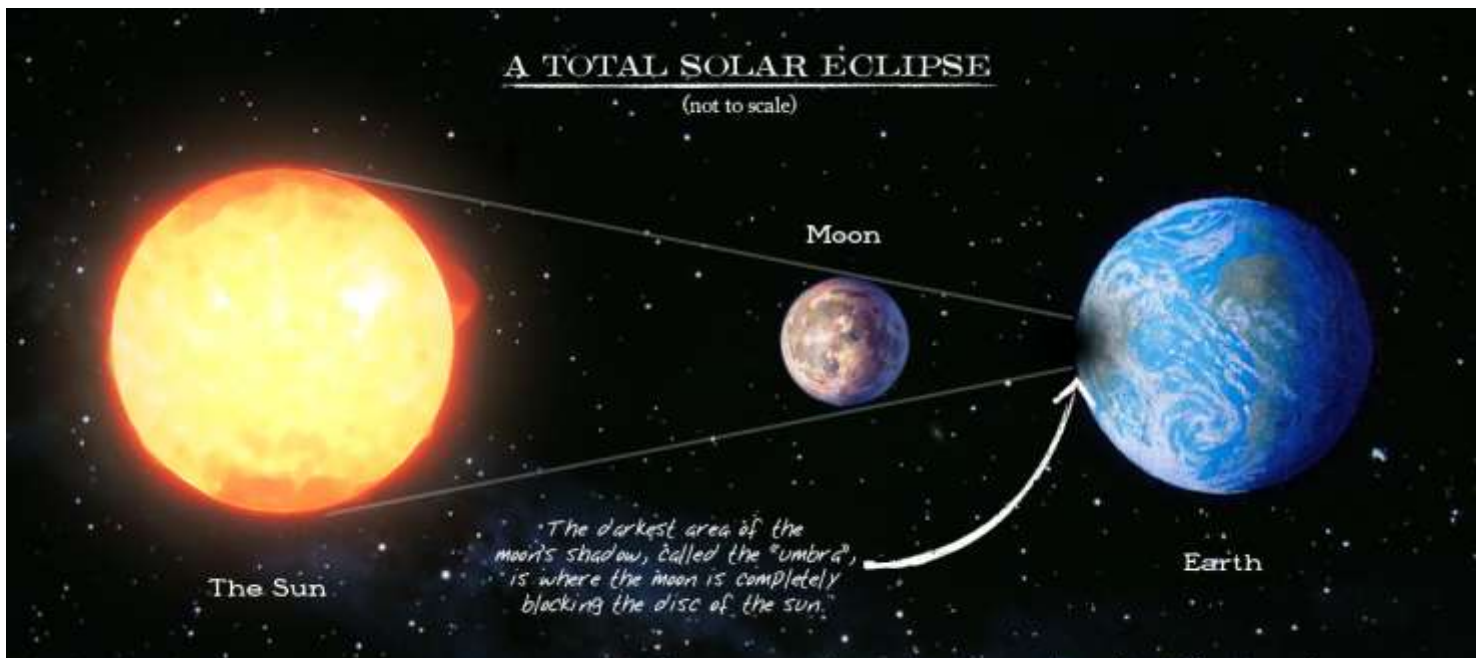
Solar Eclipse Viewing

Join us on Monday, August 21 for the Solar Eclipse!

1:30 on the front porch and sidewalk

A total eclipse of the sun will be visible in the continental United States. The sun will be completely hidden by the moon, the sky will become dark and the sun's corona will become visible. We will experience a 'partial' eclipse here in Pennington Gap. Depending upon the weather conditions, the eclipse should begin around 1pm. Approximately 91% of the sun's area will be covered. The eclipse will only last a maximum of 2 minutes and 40 seconds.

The activity dept. has CE and ISO standard safety eye protectors for residents to wear during this event.
