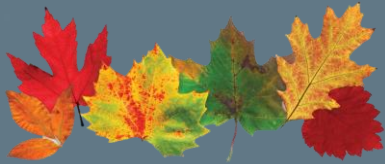

As of October 12th, Lee Health and Rehab will be proud to be offering another unique service to our patients and residents!

TripleCare is a telemedicine program that utilizes a Computer on Wheels (COW) that is able to be placed at the bedside. A physician is able to see and hear the patient through the use of cameras and Bluetooth medical equipment. The MD guides the nurse to perform a hands-on assessment and is able to determine the best course of action for the patient. The MD's are a credentialed group of 6 that specialize in this type of care. This service will be available during the hours of 6pm to 7am, Monday through Friday, and 6pm Friday until 7am on Monday, to cover the weekend.

We are thrilled to offer this at our center and know that it will continue to place Lee Health and Rehab ahead of the curve when it comes to caring for our patients.
