Benefits of Not Returning to the Hospital

Continuity of Care – Your family member will continue to receive care from the staff members who know them and are able to respond to their preferences and needs.

Delay in Care and Comfort – Your family member will not have to endure the 30-60 minute trip to the hospital, and be held in the Emergency Room for an extended period of time.

Miscommunication and Complications – Your family member will not experience any medical status miscommunication, or be exposed to other hospital-related health complications.
