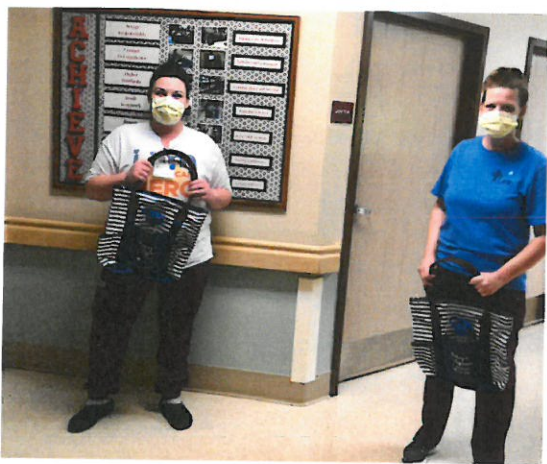

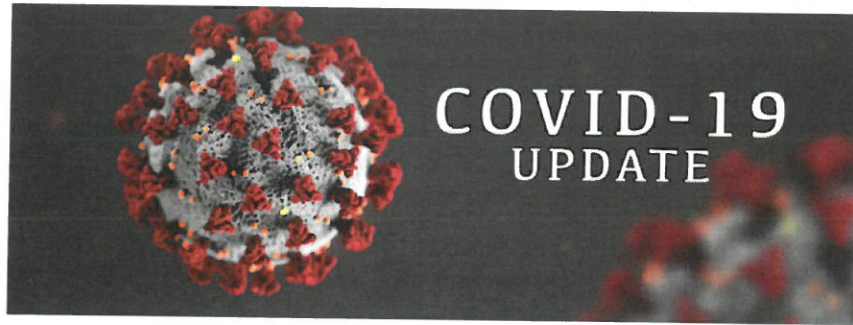

COVID-19

As of the date of this newsletter, we have no new positive test results, and the center is COVID-free. A total of 2 staff members have tested positive for the virus and both have met the CDC's return to work criteria.

Mitigation

We continue to implement our reopening plan in accordance with the Virginia Department of Health's Nursing Home Guidance for Phased Reopening. The Center has officially entered Phase 2 of reopening. The center must remain in Phase 2 for 14 days without a new nursing home onset case in a patient, before advancing to Phase 3.

All patients continue to be screened for signs or symptoms of COVID-19 during each shift, and staff members are screened at the beginning and end of each shift.

Testing

We have now completed 2 rounds of point prevalence testing, neither of which revealed an additional positive test result.

Any staff members or patients who become symptomatic will be tested immediately.

PPE

As reported through NHSN, we have an adequate supply of PPE and have resumed normal use of our PPE. Staff continue to wear masks universally throughout the center and patients wear masks when leaving their rooms and when care is being provided to them.

Visitation

As our community has seen an increase in COVID-19 cases, we are continuing to offer video calls and phone updates on your loved one to keep you informed of any changes in condition or simply to allay your concerns. We hope to be able to offer outdoor visits once the prevalence of COVID-19 in the community begins to decline. We are maintaining a positive atmosphere in the center by continuing to offer special events and outdoor activities to patients.

Communication

While the summer months provide opportunities for patients to enjoy the sunshine and time outdoors, a card or note from a family member, friend, or an anonymous community member is always a welcomed treat for patients. We invite you to flood your loved one with cards to remind them that they are loved.

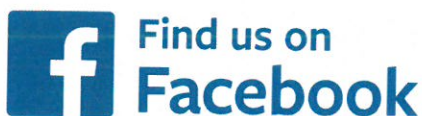
